**Stuff the Bus in 2021**—*Stuff the Bus*, a program of Sunshine Place, will once again provide backpacks and school supplies to Sun Prairie families in need for the 2021–2022 school year. The extra expense of school supplies is a struggle for many in our community, and this program strives to help families by providing these necessities.



The 13<sup>th</sup> annual **Stuff the Bus** program will continue with some changes made last year regarding how backpacks are filled with supplies. They will not be accepting physical donations of school supplies. **Instead, they are asking for the community’s support to help reach their fundraising goal of \$24,000 to purchase backpacks and school supplies.** Details of this year’s fundraiser are as follows:

- **Stuff the Bus** will support 1,500 students in Sun Prairie by providing backpacks pre-filled with school supplies needed for the start of the school year.
- Each backpack filled with necessary school supplies is approximately \$25 per child.
- Monetary donations will be combined with sponsor dollars from community groups and businesses, including The Bank of Sun Prairie, Smokey Anderson’s American Family Agency, and Costco, among others still being confirmed.
- **Stuff the Bus** needs the community’s help to raise the \$24,000 remaining needed to help 1,500 students this year.


## New Software Program for Volunteer Information
