<sup>27</sup>My sheep hear my voice. I know them, and they follow me. <sup>28</sup>I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one will snatch them out of my hand. <sup>29</sup>What my Father has given me is greater than all else, and no one can snatch it out of the Father's hand. <sup>30</sup>The Father and I are one." (John 10:22-30)

We hear a lot of voices today in our lives. Sometimes, I think it is hard to pick out the ones we should be listening to. How do we do that? I think we choose which voices we want to adhere to. Unfortunately, in our world, everything has become political. We watch only the kind of news we want to hear on television or listen to on the radio. We get lost in the voices that clamor the most or make the biggest headlines. I think it is difficult to hear God speaking to us because we think that God must speak in loud decibels, or through bombastic occurrences. We think that God must be loud and in charge and so where do we look for God? Most often we find ourselves listening to those people who say they know what God wants. But as Jesus talks about in this 10<sup>th</sup> chapter of John, Jesus is the good shepherd who looks out for his sheep.

Shepherds have to know the sheep they are to watch over because each sheep is an individual sheep and so the shepherd needs to know its personality and nuance. Imagine that our shepherd knows us intimately in a way that the shepherd knows us better than we know ourselves. That can be a bit scary. I have to admit that there are times when I would just as soon have a shepherd that tells me what I need to do in order for everything to work out. In the midst of turbulent times, war, famine, violence, the pursuit of raw power for power's sake, it is easy to just pray that God would take care of us. But I wonder if we are looking for God in the wrong places. Elijah was hiding out in a cave for fear of the King and Queen's troops, and he prayed that God would deliver him. He was scared and he had a right to be. But God did not speak to him in the mighty storms, or winds or earthquakes, but rather in a still small voice.

So how often have you found yourself just taking a moment to listen for that shepherd's voice in the stillness of time? What do you think God is really up to in this world? As my mom floats between life in her dementia and heaven she reminds me that God is love. That is what it is all about. This is what Jesus told her a couple of weeks ago. I find this to be comforting. I wonder how long it will take us to swing the pendulum back towards love in our society, for that is what God is about. Maybe if we stop and hear his voice more often we could find ourselves bearing witness to God's love in ever new ways. This is my prayer for today. Blessings in your quiet moments and in your listening.

## Tra-la, It's May!

No, this title does not refer to "The Lusty Month of May," a song from the 1967 musical "Camelot." This title refers to a time of both seeking understanding of Jesus' resurrection and celebrating it. May 2022 is in the middle of that 50 day (a week of weeks) time from Easter Sunday, which we celebrated on April 17, and the Day of Pentecost, which we will celebrate on June 5.


To aid in our musical observance and understanding of the resurrection, and in the time forward, we have a new hymnal supplement entitled "All Creation Sings." As the hymnal supplement "With One Voice," published in 1995, added to the resources in the green "Lutheran Book of Worship," published in 1978, "All Creation Sings," published in 2020, adds to the resources in "Evangelical Lutheran Worship," published in 2006.

Included in "All Creation Sings" are two new settings of the liturgy, 200 songs and hymns, and more. Though the texts of the hymns and songs may be new, not all of the melodies are new. Hymns and songs are in singable keys and the music is drawn from a wide range of ethnic backgrounds.

We will use this new musical supplement as texts are appropriate to the theme of worship for the day and the melodies are readily singable.

## **Adult Education and RIC Conversation Update**

Our initial conversation about becoming an RIC congregation was well-attended and involved wonderful conversation! There was consensus among the 20+ people present that OSLC should move forward with the process, and include as many congregational members as possible as we move forward. Aside from unanimous agreement that Our Savior's should become an LGBT+ affirming congregation and explicitly say so in our welcome statement, many felt that it was frankly overdue, and should not be delayed any further.

We will continue the conversation in this format for the first two Sundays in May (May 1 & 8), then start to incorporate the conversation into worship services in various ways to give everyone a chance to learn about the process and speak into the process.

Then on May 15 & 22, the Adult Ed hour (9:15-10:15 on Sunday mornings in the chapel) will be used for a New Member class, as we have quite a few households wanting to join Our Savior's! Look for more information in the Evangelism section below.
