## From Pastor Hecox

Spring is a time of Resurrection. Easter is right in the middle of the season this year. If you look closely, by then, some of your plants and flowers may start showing signs of life. People with a green thumb like my wife have waited for the moment when seeds can go in the ground after a long, cold, dark winter.

Resurrection is so much more than just the idea of something that happened two thousand years ago. We Christians sometimes think solely in those terms, but the notion carries much more weight, and can be a powerful reality in your life even now. We awaken from the minideath of sleep each morning. We emerge from the hibernation of winter each spring. We emerge from the cocoon of COVID together now. Deaths, endings, and shutdowns are happening around us all the time.

But so are births.

So we approach this holy mystery once again with renewed awe. Seeing with the fresh perspective of a people re-engaging collective church life after years of isolation, we wonder at the beauty of Resurrection again. As one thing ends, so another thing begins.

So what will rebirth look like for you this April?

Perhaps you will see loved ones you haven't visited in a long time. Perhaps you will finally take that vacation you've postponed for years. Perhaps you will delight in the church activities that were not possible for so long. Perhaps you will call Pastor Tim and air your grievances because he's a great listener and incredibly patient (haha, I'm joking, but I do love it when you voice issues to him and not me, for I am of little patience, I confess).

Regardless of how you will experience Resurrection this Spring, or how you've experienced it in the past, the Resurrection of Jesus Christ is for you. For you, personally, as a beloved child of God. For you, collectively, as a people made into the family of God. For you, as a species, to imagine a way to live on this planet for the benefit of every living thing.

Resurrection life is yours. It is yours now. It is the power to let go. The power to not fear. The power to live free of anxiety and dread. The power to not have to be in control. The power to get out of the rut you find yourself in. The power to love without guarantee of reciprocation. The power to give without expecting anything in return. The power to envision brand new ways of living. The power to find joy in even the simplest things in life.

Thank you for claiming the Resurrection life with me. Christ died and was buried, so we too, portrayed in our baptisms, have been united with Christ, so that just as he died and was raised, so we shall be too. So we are now as well. Raised to new life. Raised to abundant life. Raised to live as God's people who rejoice together at what God has done and is still doing among us. Amen.


