Did you know that passing on the faith is mentioned in Scripture? Timothy was blessed with a mother and grandmother who intentionally shared the faith with him. Sweet.

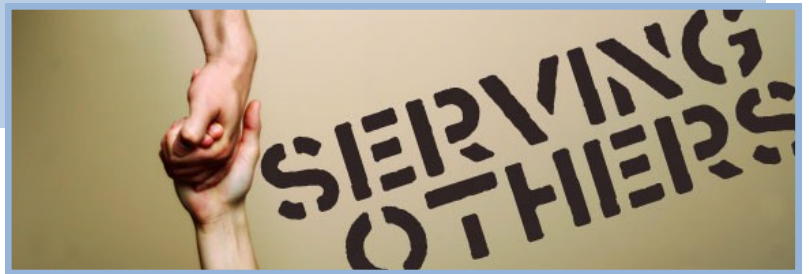
There are numerous occasions for that to happen, of course. Family conversations, guided by the family credit form, that follow family service opportunities can create an opening for that faith talk.
