New Year, New Era at Our Savior's

As we enter another year together here at Our Savior's, we do so in transition. All sorts of things are changing, so we pause for a moment to take a look around and acknowledge what's happening around us. We say goodbye to some people and times, while simultaneously looking with expectation to what God has in store for us as a people of faith.

Last Sunday, we said farewell to our longtime organist and music director John Krueger. He did a fabulous job for 28 years here in our midst. He is responsible for procuring the beautiful pipe organ which graces our sanctuary. He played at countless worship services and funerals. He organized food pantry concerts and facilitated music events of all kinds. He was adaptable, as he worked with different pastors, pulled off different styles of music, and accommodated vocalists and instrumental soloists from a wide variety of styles. John, we thank you and want you to know you always have a home here with us.

This next Sunday, we will have another ending as we say farewell to Pastor Peter Bredlau. As his six-month interim contract draws to a close, we recognize his work here among us. Peter, thank you for facilitating conversations, for preaching and teaching, and for serving God's people faithfully here at Our Savior's these past several months. May God continue to lead you into opportunities to build up the kingdom and may you find ways to use your gifts to the edification of the body of Christ for years to come.

Of course, it's not all goodbyes. We welcome Bekah Morano into a larger role. You may be familiar with her, especially if you worship at the 10:30 service. She's been playing with the worship band for a couple years and has been leading it for the last several months. In addition to singing, playing guitar and piano well, Bekah also plays the organ very well! So we are blessed to have a depth of musical gifts in the congregation so that there's no gap in organ playing at Our Savior's as we go through this particular transition.

Aside from staff transitions, we also acknowledge the political transitions about to take place in our country. It gives us reason to love and comfort each other like never before. Additionally, the new year is upon us, and it reminds us once again that our lives are never in a static, fixed state. We are, all of us, dynamic creatures. We experience change with every breath we take and are constantly in transition. This is true of us as individuals, and it's true of us collectively as a church body. While our individual minds and hearts grow and adapt, so does our collective conscience and experience as a people. Through all of it, we give thanks that we are not alone: we have each other to laugh and cry with, to lean on for support, and take care of each other as the ups and downs of life come our way.

A Note from OSLC's Treasurer:

The 2024 Giving Budget is \$668,500 and as of November 80% has been raised. The 2024 Expenditure Budget is \$729,300 and as of November 87% has been spent.

The Cash Flow was a negative \$4,477 at the end of November and Year-to-date was a negative \$44,283.

Mortgage payment this month included \$2,218.69 in interest and \$4,884.31 in principal.




Women's Ministry




Youth and Family


A Call to Justice and Mercy (JAM)




