What is success looks different through God's eyes. So we live to proclaim it and live it so that others might understand this faithfulness of God towards us.

As we look back at these sixty years we can see the bold leadership of those who understood this faithfulness well and lived to bear witness to God's love. Where does that leave us? How are we doing? What is God calling you to do? How does your daily living reflect God's love and faithfulness? These are all good questions to ask at a time like this. It is exciting and worth celebrating!


Make Music a Part of Your Life Senior Choir Rehearsals Are Concurrent with Sunday School




