Lenten Greetings

Lent is one of my favorite seasons of the year.

Now, don't get me wrong: winter can be tough, and I've had my share of frustration at the gray skies this winter. Aside from the depression or Seasonal Affective Disorder that many experience, winter can be a challenge as the cold weather often brings a cold or a flu to various households in our church family, especially after a few winters of being masked or isolated from others.

I think that's why Lent feels so appropriate for this time of year. With the short days and long nights, our midweek worship services during Lent happen almost entirely after sundown. The mood can be contemplative, reflective, even somber. Ash Wednesday sets that tone for us each Lenten season, with its stark reminder of our own mortality. Remember: before we get to Easter resurrection, we must first die to ourselves during Lent and Good Friday.

So we enter this special season with ash on our forehead, and we journey through Lent together while engaging in some ancient Christian practices. Some give up a favorite food or drink. Some forego some other creature comfort they normally indulge. Some extend beyond their comfort zone to serve others in ways they normally wouldn't. Some flip the script and indulge in ways they normally wouldn't (especially after years of foregoing previously commonplace comforts). All of these are expressions of Christian praxis: in Lent, we do not simply *believe*, we also *do*.

As we participate in this ancient ritual of the church for 40 days and 40 nights, Pastor Tim and I will be bringing our church family an exploration of various signs we encounter in the journey on Earth. We don't always notice the signs (just ask any teacher or re-decorator of a bulletin board!). So this year, we'll spend some time purposefully observing the signs around us, and considering what they tell us, and contemplate how they might guide our thoughts and direct our actions.

What we observe can serve as powerful pieces of our inner selves if we give them some attention. Our experiences and observations have the power to shape us in ways much deeper than we often realize. That subtle, slow re-shaping of ourselves reorients our hearts toward God's priorities rather than our own. Lent helps to draw us out of ourselves and closer to each other and to our savior, Jesus. And these practices help us hear that still, small voice that comes to us in the darkness and the stillness and the silence: the Holy Spirit softly whispering, quietly moving in our hearts, reminding us that the winter will pass, and spring will come once again, and we will find ourselves invigorated once more, spurred on to new growth and vitality if we are patient and wait for the Lord.

When Is Easter and Why Was Ash Wednesday on February 22?—March 2023 is the central part of the season of Lent, surrounded by Ash Wednesday in February and Easter in April. But how are the exact dates set? The key is to first determine the date for Easter, which is on the first Sunday following the first full moon after the vernal (spring) equinox. The vernal equinox is on March 20 and the first full moon following that is on Thursday, April 6. That means that Easter in 2023 is on Sunday, April 9.

Now we can work backwards and find the date for Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent. The long season of Lent lasts for 40 days (and 40 nights), so count back 40 days from April 9, but you will need to make one adjustment. Do not count the Sundays. That is why the Sundays during this season are called Sundays "in" Lent and not Sundays "of" Lent.

May this season be fruitful in the growth of your faith. And remember that you can express your faith through music.

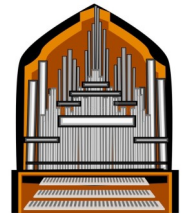
Thursday Bible Studies

July 23-28, 2023

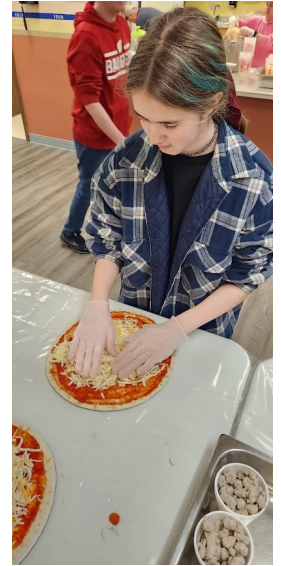
