From Pastor Hecox

June Newsletter Article

Welcome to Summer!

That's right – the summer solstice is coming. This year it arrives on Friday, June 20. There will be celebrations throughout the northern hemisphere, including here in our part of the world as we recognize the official start of summer.

Midsummer, the summer solstice, has been celebrated for centuries as the longest day of the year. In northern climates particularly, it became a spiritual festival celebrating the warmth and life-giving power of the sun. In places like Scandinavia, Iceland, and Northern Europe the solstice was traditionally celebrated with bonfires and games involving rolling hoops down hills to symbolize the sun heading back away from us on its continual course. Rather than give up this pagan tradition, early Christians in these regions repurposed the festival and named it St. John's Day. This fit the church year nicely since the gospels suggest that John the Baptist was born six months before Jesus, and Midsummer falls six months before Christmas, another "repurposed" holiday with pre-Christian roots tied to the other solstice.

This year, we get an additional reason to celebrate: Pentecost is coming on June 8. It's fitting, perhaps, that we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit in tongues of flame in the same month that the great ball of fire in the sky is nearest to our part of earth.

As I mentioned recently in a sermon, one thing about the unpredictable Holy Spirit is that she is usually depicted with images of things that can be both constructive *and* destructive: fire, wind, water. That might cause you anxiety, or it might invigorate you. Either way, we acknowledge the reality that our lives are always changing. Everything is impermanent. In order to sustain happiness, peace, and joy, we collectively learn to adapt and help each other through the inevitable changes of life.

So I encourage you in your continued journey of adaptation and growth. You journey as a beloved child of God. You don't do it alone, but rather you make the journey with this family of faith. Whatever the future brings, we have each other, a Spirit that inhabits us, and a faith that grounds us. For that we can each say "thanks be to God!




Spirited Book Club




